Harvest of Life was able to send out over 3,000 Bibles to those who are incarcerated, in the federal detention centers, and ICE facilities. We had almost 8,000 attending our classes and worship services this past year. We saw 78 men come and give their hearts and lives to Jesus and

baptized 74 men this year! Harvest of Life has traveled over 21,000 miles in 2022 to go and administer the good news!

We have THIRTEEN Christmas services scheduled in December where we will go and share the love of Jesus and pass out gifts to these men that we hope and pray will bring a little bit of light and Christmas cheer into their world.

Pray for us as I believe the Lord has big plans for Harvest of Life in 2023. We made two trips down into the central Florida regions and conducted worship services in 10 different institutions and it looks like God is expanding our territory! We are planning more trips down there and quite possibly a Harvest of Life – South team could

be forming! Pray about how you can be involved and support the Lord's work by becoming a volunteer with us, helping with fundraisers and community projects, being a faithful prayer warrior, and giving financially. So many ways to be a part of what God is doing. God is so good! Thank you for your prayers and support! We see the fruit from the seeds being sown into these men's lives now, but we anticipate an even bigger harvest coming!

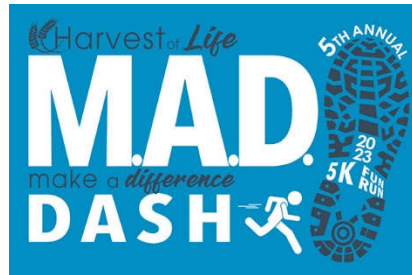

Missionary Report



I have heard all about you, LORD. I am filled with awe by your amazing works. In this time of our deep need, help us again as you did in years gone by. And in your anger, remember your mercy. HABAKKUK 3: 2

Dear ministry partner... We know that winter is here (in Florida) because the temperature actually dropped all the way down to 40 degrees last night. That said, we'd like to bring you up to date with what's been happening with Harvest of Life and the Spanish Bible project... Each day (sometimes twice a day) Marilyn makes a trip to the Post Office to drop off the Bibles to be sent and to pick up the letters from Hispanic inmates requesting a Bible. These days the P.O. Box is stuffed with letters... in fact sometimes it's overwhelming. Filling these orders has become a full-time job and we are asking our supporters to

pray with us for HELP. We are asking God to place on the hearts of local Spanish speaking Christians to help with the volume of requests for these Bibles. So far this year we have received 2,200 requests. Last year we received a little over 2,000 requests for which we send our love and thanks for your prayers and financial support. You have made a difference in over 4,200 Latin detainees in the last two years. It is amazing what the Lord is doing in the Federal Bureau of Prisons and Detention Centers across the U.S. Please keep praying! Your prayers are being answer. It's sad that it takes incarceration here in the U.S. in order for God to get the attention of those Hispanics who are now serving time. Many of them indicate in their letters that they recognize the errors (sin) and want to repent. They ask us to pray for their family now that they can't be there to care for them. Many of them thank God for the opportunity to read and study His Word in their language.
