

## SPRING 2019

Looking back at 2019 we can honestly say that it was a good and productive year for *Harvest of Life*, thanks to your prayers and financial support. You encouraged us greatly reminding us once again of just how vital you are to this ministry.

You enabled us to travel over a 1,000 miles per month to multiple prisons where we have taught 158 Bible studies (Experiencing God, Battlefield of the Mind, Bondage Breaker and How to Win in Spiritual Warfare) in Faith Based dorms. We have provided 128 Bible correspondence studies at the Women's Prison and awarded 32 Sarah Young Devotionals to those who completed them. You provided the prayers and financial support to send 1,815 Spanish Bibles along with Bible correspondence studies (in Spanish) were shipped to Federal Penitentiaries and ICE Detention Centers.



In fact, just last week we received a wonderful card from a Federal prison in Victorville, California with the signatures of 24 inmates thanking us for the Bibles they had received. We have also received letters from several individual inmates thanking us for their Bible and many of them confessing that by reading their Bible they made a decision for Christ as their Lord and

Savior. We estimate that fully 20% of the men that we have shipped Bibles to are new believers! Leading us to believe that among these detainees from Honduras, Guatemala, Mexico, El Salvador, and other Spanish speaking countries that God is doing a “mighty thing”. Revival has broken out! And Holy Spirit is adding to the universal Church each and every day. We thank God that we are able to participate in this “mighty move of God”. We’ll probably never know for sure just how many souls were saved as a result of receiving one of these Spanish Bible but we do know that in the Faith Based dorms 28 inmates made a decision for Christ in 2019 and so far this year 3 more have come to know Jesus as Savior.

Last month we had a visit from a college buddy of Dan’s. Walt Wenk was the Captain of the William and Mary basketball team and President of their Senior class. Below is the letter that Walt wrote to the Alumni Magazine.

*About a month ago, I visited Dan and Marilyn Nase to see what they have been doing for the last 40 years. As you know, their ministry is called **Harvest of Life**.*

*I went with Dan to the Wakulla Correctional Institution. Quite frankly, it was intimidating and quite scary to have the gates close behind you and effectively be locked up for two hours. However, when we entered the chapel, and faced the 70 men who Dan was ministering to, all my trepidation left.*

*One could see the look of peace on their faces as they waited in anticipation for Dan’s lesson for the day. These men understand what they did and have reconciled their punishment within their spirits. Actually, Dan has used the Word of God to free them from their bondages.*

*Dan and Marilyn have a great ministry and have given their whole life to the Lord. I saw firsthand the fruit of their labor and it is a wonderful calling.*

On Christmas eve, 125 men attended the service in the chapel at WCI. The praise band led us as we sang Christmas carols and Marilyn led as the congregation played the Christmas I.Q. Quiz (which debunks many birth-of-Christ myths). Dan brought an inspiring Christmas message and one man came forward to give his life to the Lord. PTL!



As 2019 was nearing an end we celebrated the graduation of 53 men in the Men on Mission class at Wakulla C.I. Each inmate was presented a certificate. Marilyn shared her Christian testimony and our guest speaker, Marty Slone, the College minister from our church, brought the message which the men received with enthusiasm. The celebration concluded with a time of fellowship, coffee and a delicious cake provided by the chow hall.

Please keep us in your prayers for 2020. Ask the Lord to give us another great year as we minister His Word in the prisons. **Pray too that the Spanish Bibles will bring a record number of men to Christ. Pray that those being deported back to their country of origin will use their Bible as they share Jesus with family, friends, and neighbors.** We covet your prayers for our health as well. We are getting up in age and some mornings we get up and everything hurts. Ask God to keep us going as we serve Him in the prisons of North Florida and beyond.
